




## STAY



### HOTEL VALLEY HO

Old Town's iconic Hotel Valley Ho recently completed an \$18 million room renovation. The new design seamlessly blends classic elements with contemporary styling to create an atmosphere that's both playful and polished. Hotel Valley Ho also unveiled all-new Executive Suites, which include custom-designed sofa units that convert to beds, an additional bathroom and new patio furniture.



### THE REMI SCOTTSDALE, AUTOGRAPH COLLECTION

Old Town Scottsdale's newest hotel, The REMI, opened in July 2025 with 161 curated guest rooms and suites, including two-story lofts with private patios. Guests can explore four luxurious and playful dining concepts on property, including Kauboi, an eclectic Japanese steakhouse. ### THE SCOTTSDALE RESORT & SPA, CURIO COLLECTION BY HILTON

This central Scottsdale resort recently unveiled the Stillman Villas, a secluded enclave of two-story villas that range from 1,250 to 2,500 square feet. ## DINE



### WOLF BY VANDERPUMP

Renowned restaurateur Lisa Vanderpump brought more glamour and elevated dining to Scottsdale in late 2025 with the opening of Wolf by Vanderpump at Caesars Republic Scottsdale, a Hilton Hotel. Wolf by Vanderpump, which crowns the hotel's seventh floor, wows diners with sweeping views of Camelback Mountain, an imaginative cocktail program, and a globally inspired menu featuring decadent, shareable dishes crafted exclusively for Scottsdale.



### KAUBOI AT THE REMI

Tucked inside The REMI Scottsdale in Old Town, Kauboi blends Japanese tradition with modern Western influences throughout its menu of robata-grilled specialties, fresh sushi and a curated selection of Japanese whiskies. Try delicacies from the raw menu, including Wagyu steak tartare and smoking tuna, or opt for fire-grilled seafood and prime meats like the The Kauboi Cut, a 40-ounce bone-in Senku tomahawk ribeye.



### SCOTTSDALE FASHION SQUARE

In addition to unparalleled retail delights, Old Town's Scottsdale Fashion Square welcomed a variety of new eateries in 2025. New offerings include Society Swan, an American brasserie; Catch, featuring a globally inspired menu of seafood, sushi and steak; and Teleféric Barcelona, a family-owned restaurant serving Spanish tapas and paellas. And in early 2026, Din Tai Fung, whose Hong Kong restaurants have earned multiple Michelin stars, will open its first Arizona restaurant at Scottsdale Fashion Square showcasing a menu of authentic Taiwanese soups, dumplings, noodle dishes, wontons and more.



### SHIV SUPPER CLUB

This highly anticipated addition to Old Town's culinary scene redefines luxury dining with a menu that blends top-shelf ingredients with creative presentations in signature dishes like the Truffle Butter Bread Service, Scallop Crudo with citrus buttermilk cream, and a selection of charcoal-fired prime steaks. After 9 p.m. on weekends, Shiv unveils the Dessert Room, a decadent late-night experience with extravagant desserts, champagne and elevated entertainment.



### SEXY ROMAN

Sexy Roman at the W Scottsdale is moody and sleek. Helmed by James Beard Award-nominated chef Jason Franey, Sexy Roman delivers daring twists on Italian and Mediterranean traditions, including pan-seared branzino, salmon tartare and delicious pastas like ricotta agnolotti with black truffle fonduta. But the true showpiece is a roaming cocktail and martini cart complete with nitro-chilled glassware and theatrical elegance.

The State of Arizona has officially recognized the Original Chopped Salad as an Arizona staple. This proclamation honors chef Bernie Kantak and The Gladly for their role in creating one of the state's most iconic dishes, enjoyed by over 75,000 diners annually. ## GREENBELT BIKE TOURS

Greenbelt Bike Tours offers e-bike expeditions designed to showcase Scottsdale's most iconic landmarks, hidden gems and local hotspots. Nearly a dozen tour options are available for riders of all skill levels. Rides range from 2 to 20 miles and include stops at local highlights such as Scottsdale's Indian Bend Wash Greenbelt park system, local breweries and the legendary LOVE sculpture at the Scottsdale Civic Center.



## THE SPA AT CAMELBACK INN

This iconic spa at the JW Marriott Scottsdale Camelback Inn Resort & Spa is wrapping up a \$24 million transformation that is expected to be complete in early 2026. The fully remodeled spa will offer deeply personalized and nature-connected wellness rooted in its new ariVéa philosophy — a holistic approach that blends timeless rituals with the energy and serenity of the Sonoran Desert. Highlights include hydrotherapy pools, an indoor Wellness Circuit, new Wellness Studio with sound baths and the debut of Ora Café.



## WESTERN SPIRIT: SCOTTSDALE'S MUSEUM OF THE WEST

This Smithsonian Affiliate museum in Old Town Scottsdale celebrated its 10th anniversary in 2025 with an exciting expansion project expected to be complete in spring 2026. New gallery spaces, expanded educational offerings and improved technology throughout the museum will further secure Western Spirit's standing as a premier institution for the exploration of the history and culture of the Greater American West.

## COMING SOON



In early 2026, the Scottsdale Plaza Resort & Villas will become Miralina Resort and Villas, Paradise Valley, following a comprehensive \$42.2 million transformation into a boutique lifestyle resort. The property-wide renovation will include a complete upgrade of every guest room, the introduction of new amenity spaces and pools, and reimagined food and beverage venues featuring locally sourced ingredients.



The Monarch Scottsdale, located on the lush Scottsdale Civic Center in Old Town, is undergoing a hotel-wide transformation as it relaunches under the JdV by Hyatt brand as Hotel Solaya. The changes include a top-to-bottom refresh of the 194-room property, including vibrant new dining and hospitality experiences aimed at both guests and locals.





# SONORAN DESERT Adventures

*Scottsdale's lush Sonoran Desert setting and 330 days of annual sunshine make any day a great day for outdoor exploration and adventure. Whether you're looking for a laid-back guided excursion or something a little - or a lot - more thrilling, Scottsdale has you covered with these options for exploring our sun-drenched desert landscape.*



## HOT-AIR BALLOONING

*Minimum Time Block: 3 hours*

Hot-air balloon flights score big for panoramic desert views and unlimited photo ops. Drift along with the breeze as your pilot guides you high into the air for expansive scenic vistas and dips close to the ground for glimpses of desert wildlife. Your flight concludes with a champagne toast amid the towering saguaros.

**Elevate it:** Add a catered, post-flight brunch in the desert or opt for tethered balloon flights to elevate a dinner or reception.



## OFF-ROAD TOURS

*Minimum Time Block: 2 hours*

A Jeep or Hummer tour with an experienced guide is a great way to learn about the Sonoran Desert's fascinating history, geology and delicate ecosystem. What to kick up the adventure quotient? Get behind the wheel of your own Tomcar, ATV or UTV for an exhilarating ride down rugged desert trails.

**Elevate it:** Try a combo off-road tour and river rafting or horseback riding adventure, or add a desert cookout to cap off your tour.



## BIKING

**Minimum Time Block: 2 hours**

Biking is a great (and sustainable) way to explore Scottsdale. The city boasts miles of designated bike lanes and paved paths along the Indian Bend Wash Greenbelt for urban cycling, as well as hundreds of shared-use trails in the McDowell Sonoran Preserve for mountain biking.

**Elevate it:** Take an e-bike tour that combines a scenic ride with local points of interest like public art installations. Follow the tour with dinner at an Old Town restaurant.



## HORSEBACK RIDING

**Minimum Time Block: 2 hours**

Unleash your inner cowpoke on a guided horseback ride. From your vantage point tall in the saddle, you'll enjoy stunning Sonoran Desert views as you ride through rolling mountain foothills and verdant desert washes. Beginning and experienced riders alike will enjoy this classic taste of the Old West.

**Elevate it:** Enjoy the serenity of the desert on a moonlight ride or end your excursion with a cowboy cookout under the stars, complete with live music, haywagon rides and two-step lessons.

## WATER SPORTS

**Minimum Time Block: 3 hours**

There are eight beautiful desert lakes and rivers within a 60-minute drive of Old Town Scottsdale. Take in the breathtaking scenery from the water on a guided rafting, kayaking or SUP adventure. Keep your eyes on the shoreline, where you might spot javelina, coyotes, eagles and majestic wild horses.

**Elevate it:** See the desert under a starry sky on a moonlight paddle or add a catered meal in the desert following your adventure.



# POPULAR SCOTTSDALE-AREA HIKES

*Ready to hit the trail? These popular hikes are a great place to start. Each provides easy access to the Sonoran Desert from developed trailheads with designated parking, restrooms, shade ramadas and, of course, magnificent views.*

## BAJADA NATURE TRAIL

*Gateway Trailhead (18333 N. Thompson Peak Pkwy., Scottsdale)*

**Length:** 0.5 mi / 0.8 km (loop) **Rating:** Easiest (ADA accessible)

One of the McDowell Sonoran Preserve's most popular trails, the Bajada Nature Trail is a barrier-free, fully accessible loop trail. Interpretive signage throughout the trail provides insights into how plants and wildlife interact and adapt to thrive in the desert.

## CONE MOUNTAIN LOOP

*Brown's Ranch Trailhead (30301 N. Alma School Pkwy., Scottsdale)*

**Length:** 4.1 mi / 6.6 km (loop) **Rating:** Easy

Cone Mountain is a standalone peak with gently sloping shoulders. This easy hike throws a lasso around the cone and rambles through open country dotted with magnificent saguaros. On the backside of the mountain, slabs of stone add texture to the rolling terrain.

## LOST DOG WASH TO TALIESIN OVERLOOK

*Lost Dog Wash Trailhead (12601 N. 124th St., Scottsdale)*

**Length:** 4 mi / 6.4 km (round trip) **Rating:** Easy to Moderate

This gentle out-and-back hike crosses several washes. Taliesin Overlook showcases a great variety of wildflowers every spring. The views to the northwest are expansive, and from the overlook you can look down onto Frank Lloyd Wright's architectural masterpiece, Taliesin West.

## PINNACLE PEAK SUMMIT

*Pinnacle Peak Park (26802 N. 102nd Way, Scottsdale)*

**Length:** 3.5 mi / 5.6 km (round trip) **Rating:** Moderate

This wide, smooth trail switchbacks to the top of North Scottsdale's iconic Pinnacle Peak, where you'll be rewarded with stunning city and Sonoran Desert views. Though the path is well graded with few obstacles, the elevation gain earns this hike its moderate rating.

## TOM'S THUMB – EAST END LOOP

*Tom's Thumb Trailhead (23015 N. 128th St., Scottsdale)*

**Length:** 11.1 mi / 17.8 km (loop) **Rating:** Extremely Difficult

If you're a healthy, experienced hiker looking for a challenge, this trail is for you. In addition to its length, this trail provides rigorous challenges in the form of steep, loose sections and three major climbs (2,500-foot elevation gain overall). Your efforts will be rewarded with solitude, stunning vistas, and ample plant and wildlife sightings.



## HIKING

*Minimum Time Block: 1 hour*

To fully immerse yourself in the natural beauty and tranquility of the Sonoran Desert, head for Scottsdale's McDowell Sonoran Preserve. Eleven trailheads conveniently dotted around the city provide easy access to the Preserve's 230+ miles of shared-use trails. Options range from hard-surfaced and graded interpretive paths designed to be accessible to all to challenging mountain summit climbs that will get your adrenaline pumping.

**Elevate it:** Take a guided hike for expert insight into the Sonoran Desert's unique ecosystem.





**9 The Merchantile of Scottsdale:** This boutique marketplace showcases works by more than 50 Arizona artists and craftspeople.

**10 Native Art Market:** This Native-owned store features authentic art, jewelry and fashion by more than 300 Indigenous artists.

# SCOTTSDALE History on Display

If you'd like to get a glimpse into Scottsdale's colorful past, this easy, self-guided stroll will introduce you to three historic Old Town landmarks and museums. The tour can be accomplished in about an hour, and all admissions are free.



## SCOTTSDALE HISTORICAL MUSEUM

Start your tour at the Little Red Schoolhouse near the western entrance to Scottsdale Civic Center, just east of Brown Ave.

The Little Red Schoolhouse was constructed in 1909 and over the years has served as a school, social hall and polling place, and it housed the Scottsdale Chamber of Commerce prior to becoming the Scottsdale Historical Museum. The museum chronicles the city's history through photos, artifacts and changing displays.

*As you leave the museum, turn left and proceed to Brown Ave. Turn left again and your next stop, the Old Adobe Mission, is one block ahead on your left.*



## OLD ADOBE MISSION

Scottsdale's first Catholic church was constructed of handmade adobe bricks in 1933 and features beautiful Spanish Colonial Revival architecture and handcrafted stained-glass windows. Highlights inside include the Sacristy mosaic, historical photos and a statue of Our Lady of Guadalupe.

*After touring the Mission, cross Brown Ave. and turn left.*

*The Parada del Sol Rodeo Museum is just ahead on your right.*



## OLD TOWN SCOTTSDALE PARADA DEL SOL RODEO MUSEUM

Explore Scottsdale's rich rodeo history through artifacts like ropes, saddles, historical photos and original event posters. The museum, which is housed in the historic Noriega Livery building, also includes "The Stable," a large-scale mural by Joel Coplin that depicts horses being fed in their stalls.



## DODO BIRD KITCHEN & COCKTAILS






